

RELOCATION OF UTMB HEALTH LABOR AND DELIVERY SERVICES

UTMB Health Labor and Delivery services at the League City Campus will be moving to the new Clear Lake Campus on March 30, 2019.

Maternal and newborn services will also relocate from the League City Campus to the Clear Lake Campus.

There will be NO interruption in services for our patients.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will this move occur?

The move will occur on Saturday, March 30, 2019 at 7:00 AM.

What happens if I deliver at the League City Campus just before you move? What if I'm already in labor at the League City Campus on moving day?

You will be cared for by a team of UTMB Health physicians and nurses until your discharge from the League City Campus hospital. We expect to discharge you directly from the hospital if you have delivered there. Experienced providers and staff will be located at both hospitals for several days to ensure patient care is not disrupted. We want to ensure patients have a very positive birthing experience at all UTMB Health hospitals!

I was supposed to deliver at the League City Campus. Where do I go if I'm in labor or need to come to the hospital?

If you are a patient in labor, go to the UTMB Health Clear Lake Campus hospital at 200 Blossom Street in Webster, beginning March 30 at 7:00 AM. You should plan to go to the League City Campus hospital to deliver until 7:00 AM on March 30.

Where is the new hospital located?

The hospital is located at the new UTMB Health Clear Lake Campus at 200 Blossom Street, Webster, Texas. Labor and Delivery and the Mother-Baby Unit are located on the 5th floor of the Clear Lake Campus hospital.

What happens if my baby is in the Special Care Nursery at the League City Campus on move day?

If your baby is expected to remain in the Special Care Nursery beyond an additional 24-48 hours, your baby will be transferred to the new UTMB Health Clear Lake Campus nursery. This is a beautiful 8-bed nursery with private rooms where parents can visit or stay with their infants. Our experienced providers and staff will be available in both locations during the move. Your infant will be transferred by ambulance with staff in attendance for the short ride. You will not have additional charges for this ambulance transfer.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will my doctor's offices also move?

Yes, the Women's HealthCare clinics located at the League City Campus and in Webster will move to the new UTMB Health Primary and Specialty Care Clinic located adjacent to the new hospital on the Clear Lake Campus. Effective April 1, 2019, the clinic will be renamed the UTMB Women's Healthcare Clinic, Clear Lake and will begin seeing patients at 250 Blossom Street, Suite 350, Webster, TX 77598.

I enrolled in childbirth classes at League City Campus. Where do I go now?

The Childbirth Education class coordinator will reach out to you and provide our new location for upcoming classes. The Childbirth Education classes at our Galveston location will not change.

Will my insurance be accepted at the new hospital?

There are no changes expected in insurance coverage as this is a UTMB Health facility.

Why are these services moving from the League City Campus?

The labor and delivery services will complement the care available at the Clear Lake Campus, providing patients with access to a comprehensive range of women's health care in one convenient campus location. This relocation also provides room for growth at our League City Campus.

What health care services are available at the UTMB Health Clear Lake Campus?

The full-service hospital at the Clear Lake Campus will offer the latest treatment options and advanced procedures available. Services include:

- 24-hour Emergency Department with private rooms
- Entire floor dedicated to women's services, including labor/delivery/postpartum recovery and neonatal care
- Advanced heart care
- Surgery (inpatient and same-day)
- Radiology and imaging
- And more

What are the plans for the League City Campus?

UTMB Health will continue to provide services that meet the changing needs of the communities served by the League City Campus. In 2018, additional cancer services became available at the League City Campus through UTMB's partnership with MD Anderson Cancer Center. Currently, the campus is undergoing an expansion with the addition of a new five-story South Tower with 60 additional patient beds, set for completion in 2020.
